From the north:
 Coming south on the Everett Turnpike, take the new Exit 13 (the Raymond Wieczorek Drive exit). Keep right on the ramp and follow the signs onto Route 3 South (Daniel Webster Highway). Follow it about 3.5 miles. Turn right onto Baboosic Lake Road. Just beyond the church take a right turn onto Church Street then turn into the parking lot behind the church.

From the south:
 Coming north on the Everett Turnpike, take Exit 11 to Continental Blvd and head east toward Route 3. At Route 3 (Daniel Webster Highway) turn left (i.e, north) and follow it about 2 miles. Turn left onto Baboosic Lake Road. Just beyond the church take a right turn onto Church Street then turn into the parking lot behind the church.
