Directions

From I-93. Get off I-93 at Exit 9N. Go north on Rte 3 about 1.5 miles. Turn left at a McDonald's onto Martin's Ferry Road. Eventually bear left onto North River Road, which brings you to the campus. Turn right onto Mountainview Road just before the tennis courts. Go by a white gatehouse and then turn right. Go about 250 meters and turn right into parking lot in front of the Hospitality Center.

From I-293. Get off I-293 at Exit 6 and cross the Amoskeag Bridge. Turn left (north) onto Elm Street, then take first left onto West North Street. At the end, turn right on to River Road and follow it just under 3 miles to campus. Turn left on to Mountainview Road just past the tennis courts. Go by a white gatehouse and then turn right. Go about 250 meters and turn right into parking lot in front of the Hospitality Center.
