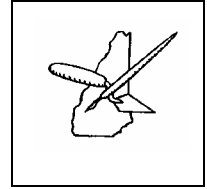

Directions: If coming south on I-495, take Exit 41 on to Rte 28 South. If coming south via I-93, take exit 44A onto I-495 North; follow I-495 North for about two miles; get off on Exit 41A and merge on to Route 28 South. Follow Rte 28 South for about two miles through the town center of Andover to reach the Phillips Academy campus.
